



## Memorandum of Understanding November 2022

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs (OFSC) and the Ontario Federation of All Terrain Vehicle Clubs (OFATV) is intended to formalize the relationship between two of Ontario's largest recreational trail organizations, the purpose of which is to:

- Work towards common goals and outcomes as it relates to the promotion, sustainability, and growth of recreational trails and organized powersports in the Province of Ontario;
- Seek alignment and partnerships between organized snowmobile and ATV clubs in the Province of Ontario;
- Support and amplify our respective messaging around seasonal trail usage, safety, trespassing, off-trail riding, and respecting landowners;
- Leverage our respective community and economic impacts to increase support from government at the municipal, provincial, and federal levels; and
- Share infrastructure and trail maintenance costs and partner on government grants and funding opportunities, where applicable.
